

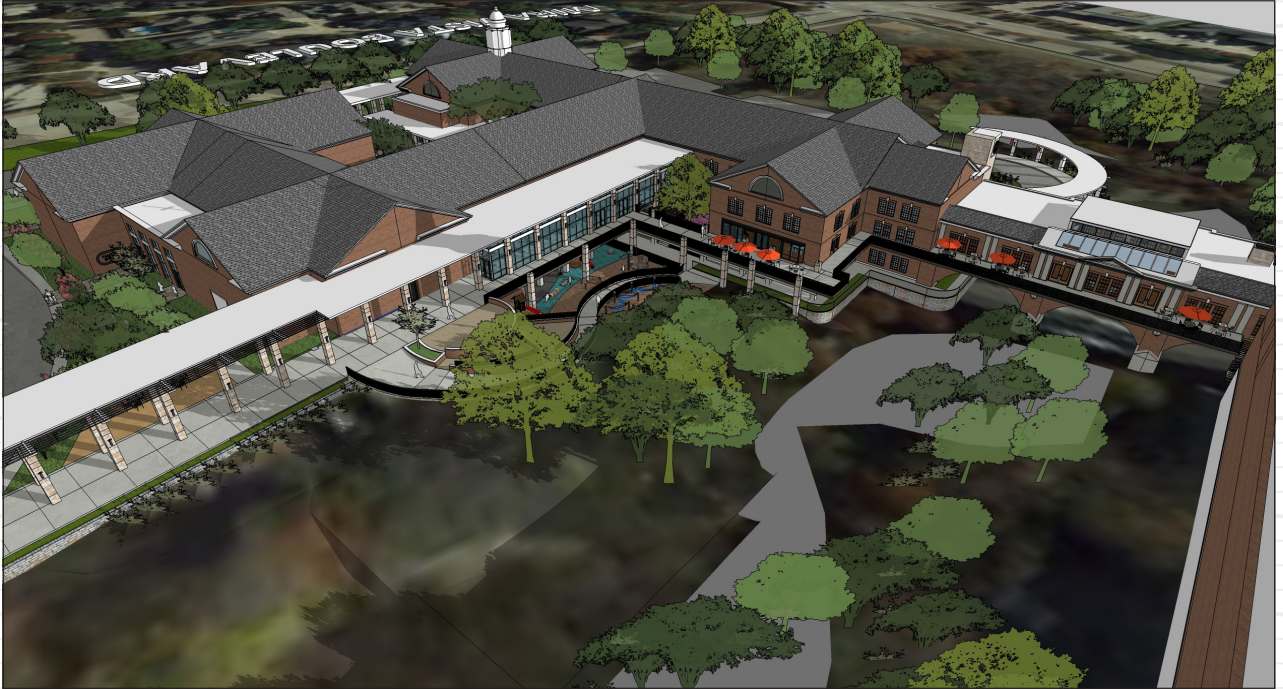
ChurchOne is a vision for the future of St. Andrew. It is a celebration of our unity in Christ and a challenge to stay focused on making passionate servants of Christ.

The purpose of ChurchOne is to progress as far as we can in addressing these needs.

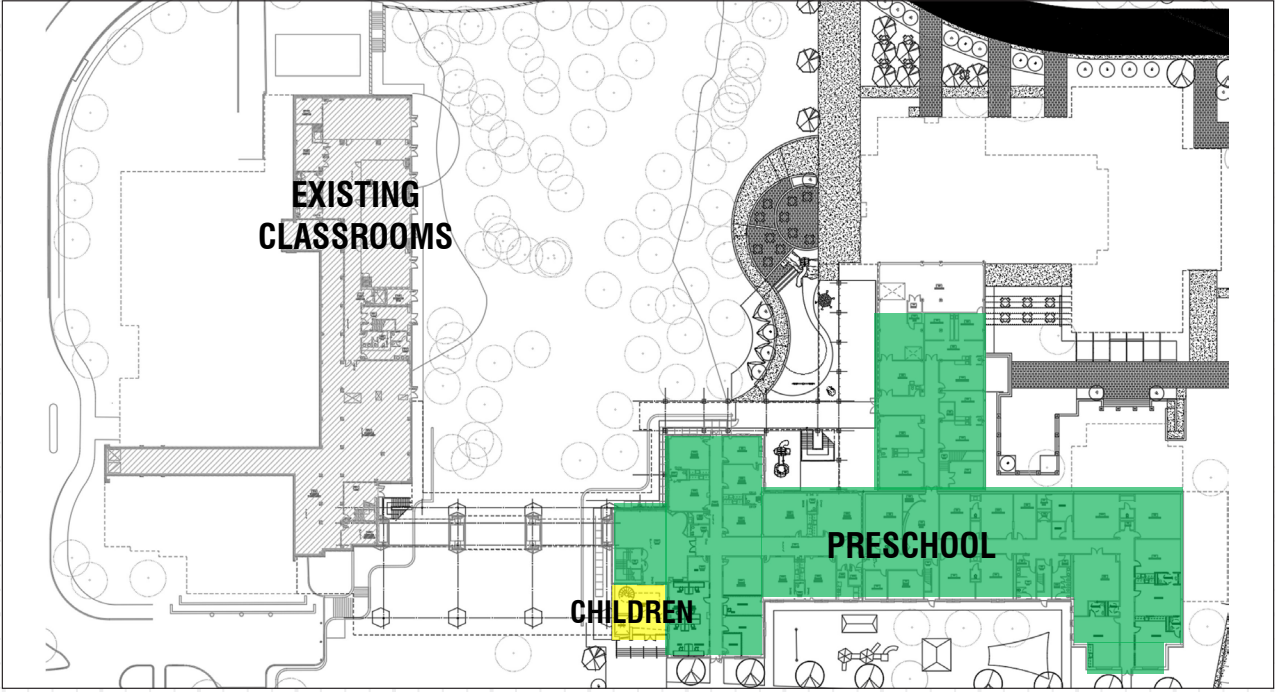

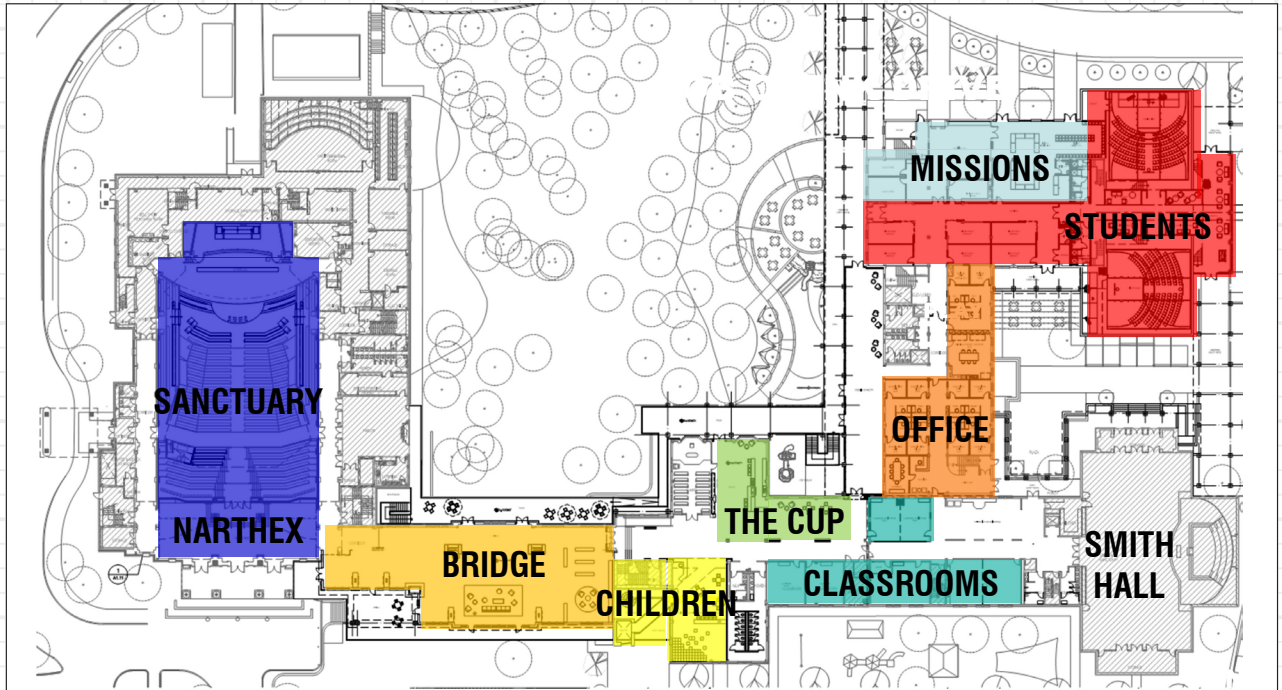


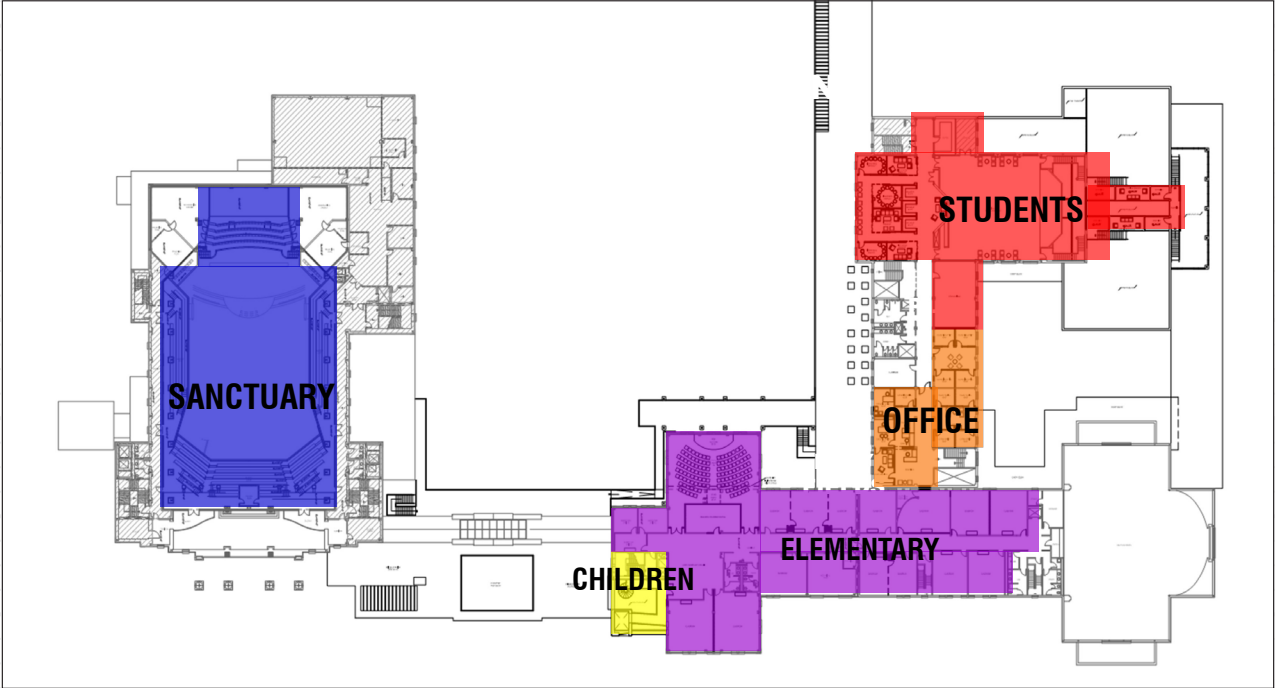
Bridge Exterior North
